Scope Electric motors are required to comply with the applicable Korean EMV and safety standards and mandatory registration before they are imported to, distributed, or sold in Korea.

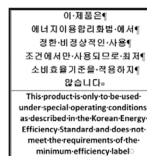
Scope

- Rated output power from 0.75 up to 375 kW
- Rated voltage up to 600 V
- Rated frequency 50 and 60 Hz
- 2-, 4-, 6- and 8-pole
- For continuous duty operation

Exemptions

- S2 short-time duty
- Inverter duty
- Motors for heavy environmental conditions like ambient temperature above +50°C or below -15°C
- Pole-changeable motors
